Child Protection education

This term, our classes are being taught child protection education from the NSW PDHPE syllabus. It is a Department of Education responsibility to ensure that effective abuse prevention programs are implemented and that all children and young people have access to the approved child protection curriculum. Although parent permission is not required under the Education Act (1972), we encourage parents/caregivers to seek further clarification if required and to provide the teacher with any relevant information about their child that could alleviate any concerns. Balanced child protection education involves teaching and learning about three themes: Theme 1, Recognising abuse, Theme 2, Power in relationships and Theme 3, Protective strategies.

Several of our school staff, students and community members will be receiving recognition awards at next week's Singleton Learning Community Education Week Awards night, to be held at Singleton Civic Centre from 6pm, on Monday, 5th August. Staff Development Day

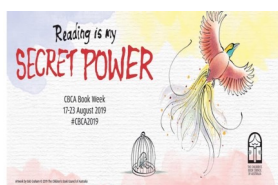
