NAPLAN Practice training – Year 3 and Year 5

All Year 3 and Year 5 students who will be participating in the NAPLAN assessment in May, will have a chance to participate in one or two practice tests (1 for Year 3, 2 for Year 5) in Week 9, on Wednesday, 24th March and Thursday, 25th March. Year 3 will complete an Omnibus test (A combination of literacy and numeracy tasks, and Year 5 will complete an online Writing and Omnibus test. No scores will be taken during these practice tests, they are simply being utilised for students to become familiar with the online testing environment, prior to the May assessment.

- Swim School lessons for Year 2 start in Week 2 and go through to Week 3 as well.
















