Cross Country

Our School Primary (Years 3 to 6) Cross Country will be held at Alroy oval next Monday. Our Year 3 and 4 students will be running the 2km course from 9:45am, and our Year 5 and 6 group will take part in the 3km run at approximately 12:15pm. If you returned your child's permission note at the start of the year, you have given permission for them to walk to and from Alroy Oval with their classroom teacher for this event. Parents are welcome to attend this event. Students will need to ensure they have a water bottle and hat to take with them to Alroy Oval. Students can still order their lunch from the canteen as the Cross Country events should be finished by 1pm.

NAPLAN Year 3 and Year 5

From the 11th May until the 21st May, our school will be participating in the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) with Year 3 and Year 5 students. NAPLAN will assess the literacy and numeracy learning of students in all Australian



schools. The results of these tests will provide important information to schools about what each student can do, and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents will receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement and will be able to compare their child's performance against the national minimum standard.

Withdrawal/Exemption/adjustments for NAPLAN

Students may be withdrawn from the tests at the request of their parent/carer. Parents will need to contact their child's classroom teacher to discuss withdrawal and complete a form, which is available in the office. Exemption from the test will require parents to consult with the principal, or their delegate, before exemption will be permitted. Consideration for exemption can be given to students: with a language background other than English who arrived in Australia less than a year before the tests, or for a student with a significant intellectual disability or condition that may severely impact their capacity to participate in the test. Disability adjustments may be made to support individual students. Adjustments permitted in NAPLAN are intended to enable access to NAPLAN on an equivalent basis to students without disability. The adjustments will reflect the kind of support and assistance provided for assessment in the classroom. Disability adjustments need to be discussed with the classroom teacher and a consent form will need to be completed before 23rd April. Forms are available in the office. If you have any other questions about NAPLAN, please contact the school to discuss with the Principal.

School Visits



On Friday, 30th April, the school will have a visit from seven other primary school principals and their executive staff, to participate in a Learning Walks trial to visit many of our classrooms and talk with our students about their learning.

On Tuesday, 4th May, the school will be receiving a visit from the Regional North and West Department of Education Executive Director, Mrs Lisa Muir. Mrs Muir will be coming in to see some of the great things happening in our school and discussing the plans we have started to implement as part of our

strategic directions in our 4 year school improvement approach.

School Assemblies

We are back to hosting assemblies in our school hall on a Thursday. Next Thursday our first K-2 Assembly is

scheduled for 12:50pm. Parents wishing to attend will need to sign in as a school visitor, and scan the Services NSW QR Code. Hand sanitiser will be made available for visitors. This will all be made available outside the school hall. Please be mindful

that you will have to socially distance when seated. Signs will be displayed on the chairs to help you with this.
