Principal's Report

I am honestly so happy to be back leading this wonderful school, after taking four weeks long service leave, backing on to the two week school holiday break. I would like to thank Ms Rose and our amazing leadership team, for leading the school so well at the back end of Term 2.

COVID Restrictions

Term 3

Unfortunately, upon my return, we have, of course, been asked to keep non-essential visitors out of the school grounds, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 Delta variant outbreak in Greater Sydney. As of the 14th July, these Level 2 restrictions will continue for regional NSW, until at least Friday, 30th July (end of Week 3). A guide to the restrictions is listed below. I do apologise for this inconvenience, and we are probably lucky in that our students are mostly used to having to find their own way out of the gates of an afternoon, after last year's restrictions. Our Kinder students and parents will be supported with an earlier finish time of 3pm each day that this continues, and we will have support staff at the school entrances in the morning, to help reluctant or worried children make their way in to the school safely.

LEVEL 2 Restrictions

- Students and staff are not to attend school if they have symptoms; a negative COVID-19 test is required prior to returning to school
- Non-essential visitors not allowed on-site (including parents and carers)
- Mask wearing recommendations
- Activities such as singing, chanting, choirs, bands and school performances allowed in outdoor settings only
- Assemblies must have COVID-Safe practices in place and no parents/carers are allowed
- Excursions within Local Government Area only, and strongly recommended to be outdoors and within walking distance
- QR code check-in and check-out required for all staff and visitors

School Activities and Excursions

Many of our school activities have had to be adjusted because of the COVID restrictions, and we are unaware of how long restrictions will remain in place.



Our Year 3 Sydney excursion, scheduled for Thursday, 5th August, will be cancelled. Families will receive a note requesting what you would like to do in regards to the payments that have been made. You may choose to accept it as a credit amount and be added as fees in advance for your child's future school excursions or costs. Alternatively, you may wish to request a refund.

Year 6 Canberra Excursion

It is difficult to know what situation we will find ourselves in at the end of August, when our planned excursion to Canberra is scheduled to take place. At the moment, overnight and interstate excursions are not permitted, but we are hopeful that this situation could change during the next six weeks. As such, we will continue to prepare and plan the excursion in the hope that we will be able to go. Please be assured, that we will update you immediately if the decision is made that the excursion must be cancelled. If the excursion is cancelled, you will be refunded all money that you have paid. In the meantime, we ask that you work with us to continue in preparing for the excursion. Just a reminder that the medical form is due back before Friday 16th July.

Year 4 overnight Sydney excursion

This will likely be cancelled. We will update families after the 30th July, when a decision will be made. No notes or money has been sent out as of yet.

Instead, we are sending home a goal setting document for your children. The teacher has written two academic goals that they feel your child should be working on this semester, based on last Semester's report. On the document, your child will also have an opportunity to record a personal school goal, and parents will have space to provide an additional comment. These documents will then be returned to your child's classroom teacher as a focus for your child. The document will go home in an envelope at the end of Week 3.

Our school Public Speaking competition will still proceed. Speeches are being held this week and next week, with the finals being held on Wednesday, 28th July, in the school hall. The Zone final which was to be held at Muswellbrook South PS, on Wednesday, 4th August, has been postponed to a later date.

P&C News

Breakfast Club - Our Breakfast club is currently not operating, due to our wonderful coordinator, and several of our regular volunteers, having to pull out of supporting this program. We are currently seeking volunteer support, to allow this initiative to continue, and we will notify students and the community once we are able to operate again.

Fundraiser Order Forms will be sent home on Thursday and are due back on Thursday 29th July. Orders can be made on Flexischools as well. We also have new security cameras installed at the school, to help with security issues that have happened in the last 12 months. Just be mindful that one of the security cameras in the office area is broadcast on a closed circuit tv in the foyer area as well, a requirement from the School Security Directorate.
